

CE marking according to Pressure Equipment Directive 2014/68/EU

The products of KRAISS & FRIZ e.K. fall under the Pressure Equipment Directive 2014/68/EU. The equipment parts / assemblies are considered as pressure-bearing equipment parts and assemblies (Art. 2, Para. 5).

They must not be CE marked as they fall under the provisions of Art. 4, Para. 3.

Extract:

Fluid-Groups:

**Group 1 = flammable, oxidising, corrosive and toxic fluids
(e.g. acetylene, propane, oxygen)**

**Group 2 = neutral fluids
(e.g. inert gases)**

A CE marking must be made:

- For fluids in group 1, if their DN is greater than 25.
(Annex II, diagram 6)
- For fluids in group 2, if their DN is greater than 32 and the product
PS (maximum operating pressure) x DN is greater than 1000 bar.
(Annex II, diagram 7)

Pressure equipment and/or assemblies which do not attain more than the specified limit values must not bear the CE marking referred to in Article 18.
